

An Atlas O no. 6907 lumber company or Walthers no. 933-3305 dairy can be used to represent a small, rail-served industry

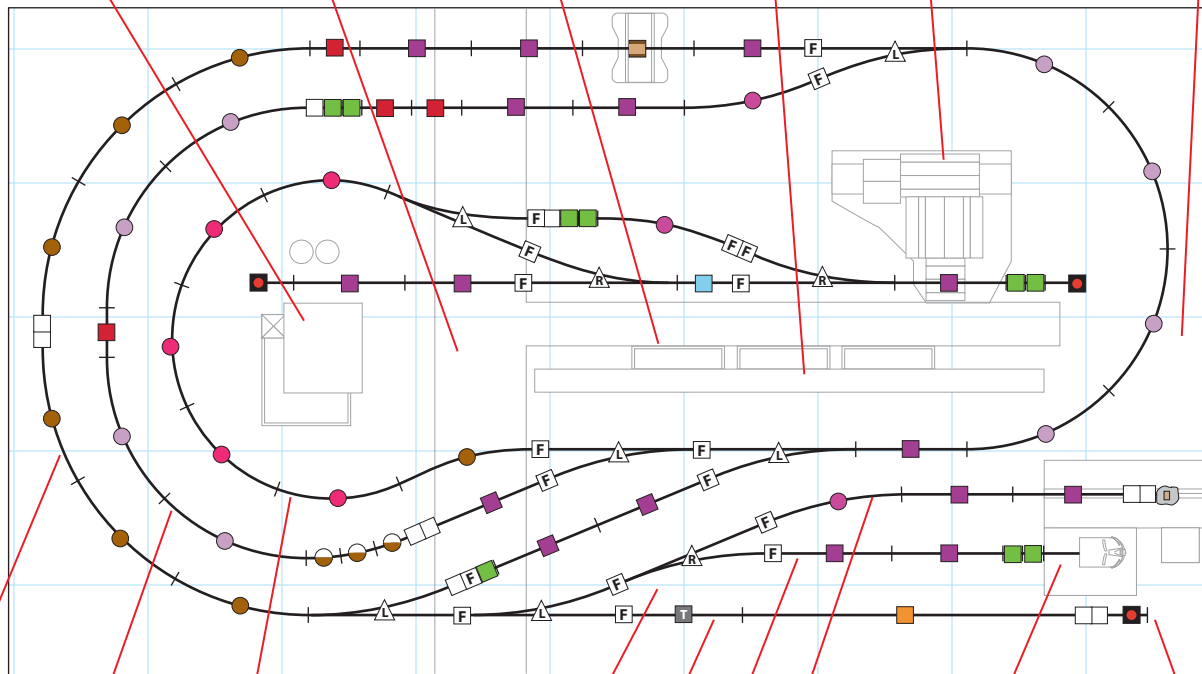
Build a highway overpass used to route traffic up and over the railway action around Red Wing

Partial buildings or structure fronts can be used to represent the backside of structures along Main Street in Red Wing

Install a double-sided, view-blocking backdrop to help visually separate Red Wing from the yard

The Lionel no. 12726 grain elevator is a key industry at the heart of the Red Wing community

Position trees to hide track routing behind backdrop
