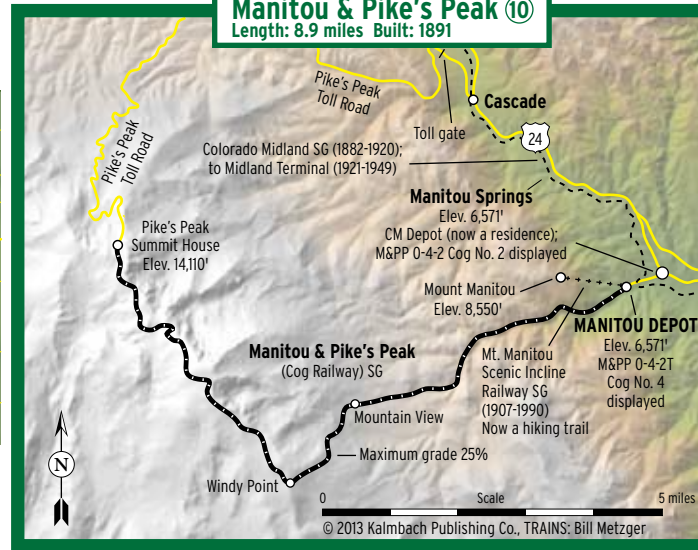

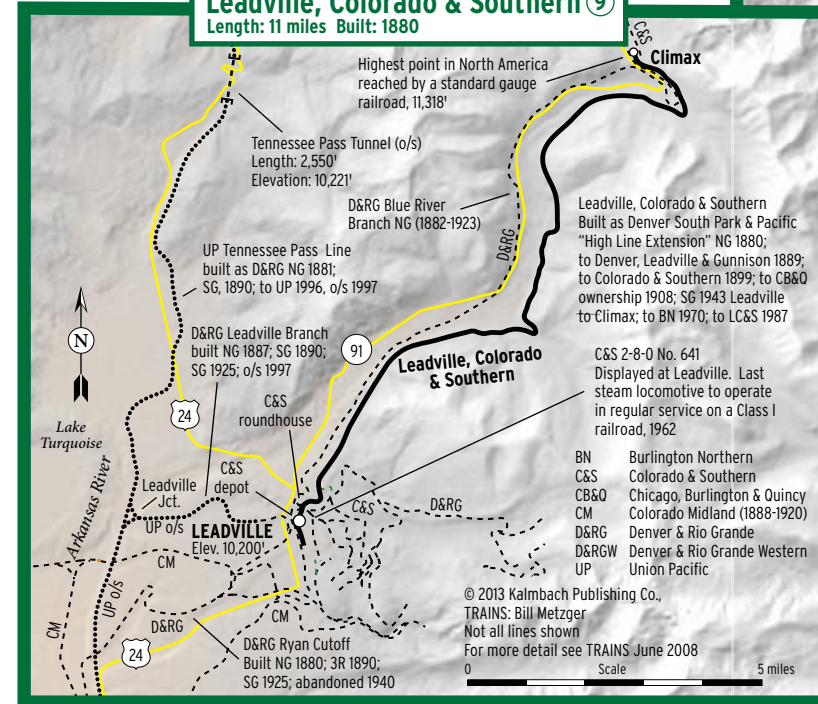
### Manitou & Pike's Peak 10

Length: 8.9 miles Built: 1891



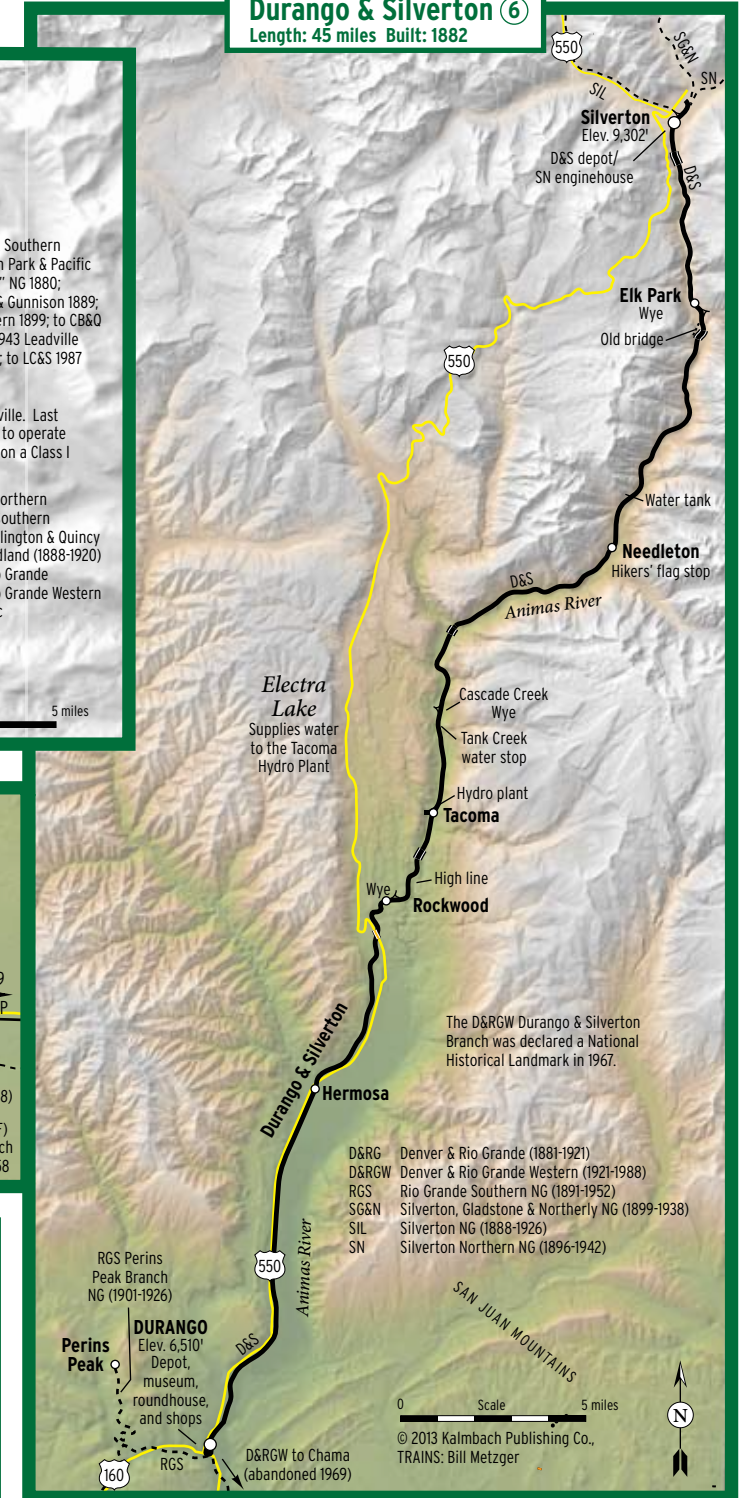
### Leadville, Colorado & Southern 9

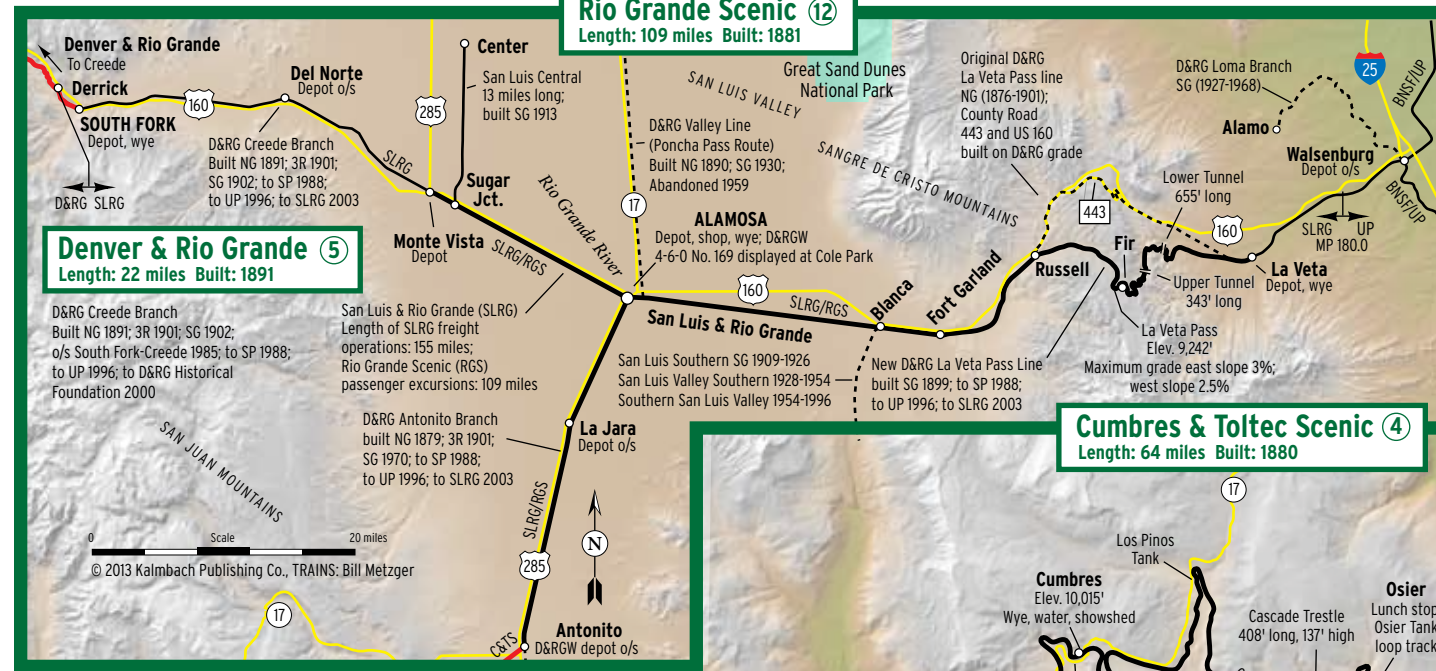
### Durango & Silverton 6

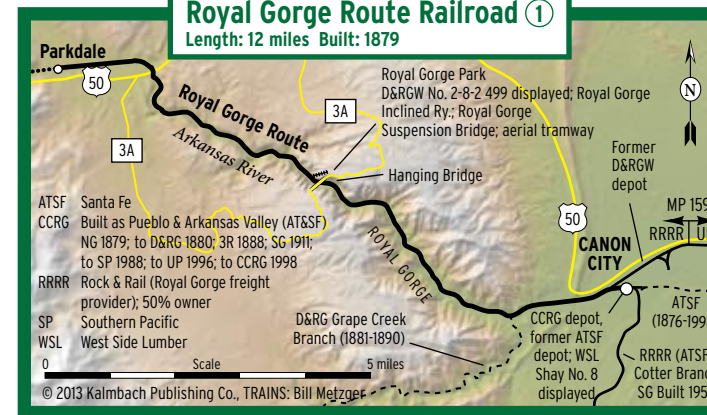
### Rio Grande Scenic 12

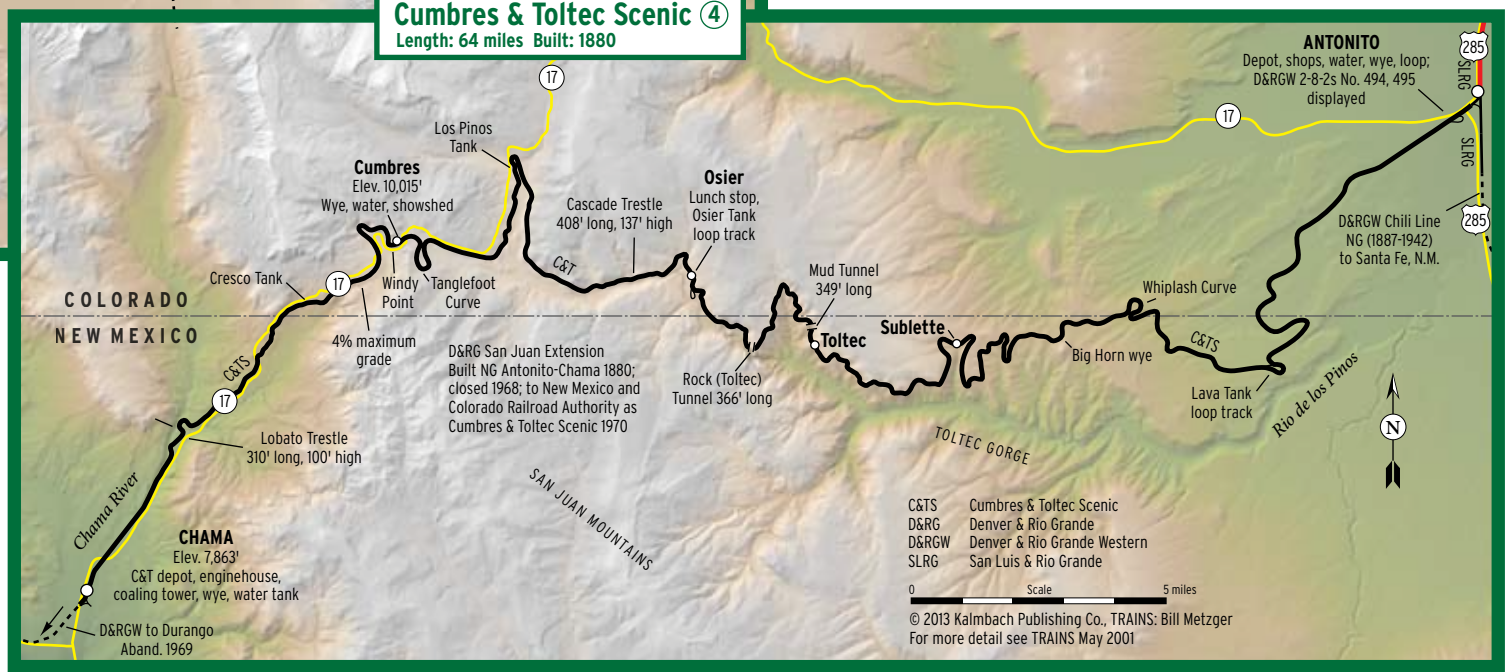
