IN THE AUGUST 2016 ISSUE, Jack Verducci describes techniques to make windows using a laser cutter. He has shared these full-size files with our readers.


Basic window laser cut from 1/16" acrylic.

Glazing Muntins & Mullions

Mullions

Outside window frame

window sill 1/16" x 1/16" Styrene strip This opening is slightly smaller than the muntins & mullion and glazing assemble providing a ridge to hold the glazing.




Assembled window
