**Scale:** HO scale (1:87.1)  
**Size:** 16 x 30 feet  
**Prototype:** St. Louis-San Francisco Ry. (Frisco)  
**Locale:** St. Louis to Springfield, Mo.  
**Era:** late 1950s to late 1960s  
**Style:** double-deck walk-in
